People have been managing forest pests using insecticides for over 100 years, and this is currently a hot topic. In this presentation and Q and A, Dr. Mark Kuhlberg draws from his latest book, *Killing Bugs for Business and Pleasure: Canada's Aerial War Against Forest Pests,* 1913-1930, to address some of the major myths and misconceptions that surround our forests and the people who manage them.
