

Annual Snowmobile/ATV Poker Run

Objective

Collect five token cards of different colours at each of the five checkpoints along the trails. These coloured cards are exchanged at the end for playing cards, to draw a Poker Hand.

By accepting a starting number for this event, each participant acknowledges and accepts the rules and conditions as set out below, including the Waiver of Liability:

Rules and Conditions

1. The <u>checkpoints</u> have been placed so that the average rider can easily finish the run without haste. Individuals or groups of riders are free to choose any route they wish.

Checkpoints are located at:

- Black Lake Hunt Camp
- Lost Lake Hunt Camp
- L'Azure Lake Shelter Cabin
- Depot Lake Shelter Cabin
- Duck Lake Shelter Cabin
- 2. <u>**Registration**</u> for the run will commence at 8 A.M. and close at 2 P.M.
- 3. <u>Checkpoints</u> will be open from 9 A.M. to 4 P.M.
- 4. All riders must be back at Base Camp <u>before 5 P.M</u>. to draw their poker hand at the Seminar Building. Arrivals later than 5 P.M. will not be considered in the awarding of prizes.
- 5. <u>The Poker Run is NOT a race</u>. Speed is not of importance. All participants have equal opportunity to win. Participants found speeding or driving recklessly will be eliminated from the event immediately and asked to leave without refund. Participants are asked to stay on the right-hand side of trails.
- 6. Participant will receive a <u>registration number</u>. This number will have to be produced at the finish in order to obtain up to five poker cards, corresponding to the number of coloured token cards produced.
- 7. The five playing cards will determine the <u>winners of the first three prizes</u> according to the posted poker rules. Should there be two participants with the same sequence of winning cards; the draw of a further single card will determine the final standing. The higher card according to poker rules wins.
- 8. Prizes will be handed over to the winning participants immediately.
- 9. <u>Final decisions</u> are left to the management of Haliburton Forest. Haliburton Forest may decide to take dispute to an independent arbitrator.
- 10. All other draw prizes will be awarded throughout the afternoon as participants finish the run.

Regulations and Waiver of Liability

- 1. <u>Provincial Liquor Laws</u> must be complied with! Liquor cannot be consumed outside any private area (cottage, tent, trailer, etc.) No alcoholic beverages are to be consumed before or while riding the trails or in shelter cabins. Zero tolerance will be given.
- 2. <u>Garbage</u>, including empty bottles, cans, etc., are to be taken off the property at the time of departure or deposited in the distinctly marked garbage containers.
- 3. Participants are not to <u>trespass</u> on the property surrounding trailers, cottages and hunting camps with exception of buildings designated and marked for the use of snowmobilers/ATVers.
- Participating snowmobilers/ATVers are advised to <u>use care and caution at all times</u>! Careless or reckless operation of snowmobiles/ATV's, including excessive speed or racing is not permitted. The maximum speed is <u>50 km/h</u> or less, subject to terrain and trail conditions.
- 5. Participants are advised to stay on <u>designated trails</u> and in the proper traffic lane. On lakes snowmobilers are advised to stay on the staked trail designation and away from any open water.
- 6. Any breach, whether intentional or otherwise, of the <u>regulations and waiver of liability</u> referenced in this document to use the lands of Haliburton Forest entitles the management of Haliburton Forest to cancel any permission without refund.
- 7. Haliburton Forest cannot and does not pretend to eliminate <u>all the hazards</u> posed by branches, brush, fallen trees, stumps, rocks, bumps, holes, blind corners, two-way traffic, weakened ice and any other dangerous or hazardous conditions. Guests are advised to use caution at all times.
- 8. Each user and guest is obligated to carry and have in place, <u>sufficient liability insurance</u> for coverage against personal and property damages to any third party, including Haliburton Forest and confirms by accepting these rules that such insurance is in place.

HALIBURTON FOREST, ITS STAFF, MANAGEMENT OR AGENTS, SHALL NOT BE LIABLE FOR ANY PROPERTY DAMAGE OR PERSONAL INJURY TO THE PERMIT HOLDER OR HIS/HER FAMILY ARISING FROM THE USE OF THE PROPERTY OF HALIBURTON FOREST OR FOR ANY OTHER REASON WHATSOEVER, NOR SHALL HALIBURTON FOREST BE LIABLE FOR ANY SICKNESS ARISING FROM THE USE OF WATER OR OTHER CAUSE.
